

SECTION 28 SE (28.4) LOT 110.

On February 21, 2013, Fred Zahn sent an email with a photo in the Attachment showing the three bases of tombstones which had been uncovered, next to the John Hagey marker at the City Cemetery. On that day, a new tombstone was being placed for Richard Hagey, died. 2012.

Research Tools: 1908 Plat Map of Section & Lots; Smith Inscriptions (1908); 1909 Alphabetical List of the Dead; Interment Books (beginning 1846); Garrett Inscriptions (1971); Tombstones Survey 2005. All of these Research tools are on the City Cemetery website.

There were 10 names of persons, with identified tombstones, buried in Lot 110 on the 1908 Plat. Inscriptions and data were listed in 1908 & 1909 & 1971. Names shown with ID numbers indicate there were tombstones with inscriptions 2005. Only birth & death years are given below. Names are listed, top to bottom on the lot.

Robert H. Sanders Died 1829. 32<sup>nd</sup> Year of his age. ID # 280326

Araminta F. Caseday Died 1829. 23 years old. ID # 280344

John L. McCurdy 1797-1831 ID # 280346

E. M. Eggleston Died 1834 NO Tombstone 2005

E. Furtwangle Died 1835. 21 years old. NO Tombstone 2005

B. S. Forbes 1803-1836 ID # 280350

Mrs. C. Hagey \* 1755-1861. Broken original & new marker ID # 280351

Note: Interment book. Catherine Hagy 106 years old.

US Census 1860 Davidson County Catherine Hagey 106 years old.

**(Three underground tombstone bases next to John Hagey's marker in 2013)**

Hagey was spelled Hager in (Smith) 1908 Inscriptions and 1909 Alphabetical list. A change can be seen in the spelling to "Hagey" on the altered 1908 Plat on City Cemetery website.

At some point after 1971, a large marker was placed in the lot for John Hagey. Died 1841. (ID #280352 in 2005). The marker was placed adjacent to Mrs. Catherine Hagey, his wife. In 1908 & 1971, no inscription was read on a tombstone for John Hagey. The inserted name "John Hagey" was added to the 1908 Plat on City Cemetery website.
