City Cemetery Lot Deed Books 1843-1874 for Lots

Certain lot piece or parcel of ground  
lying & being in Nashville Cemetery  
situate at the north side of Kingsley

Walk and between Maple & Turnpike avenues  
Beginning at a stake at the north side of Kingsley Walk  
running thence north seventeen feet to a stake at  
Mrs. Sarah Kings corner thence west with her line ten feet  
to a stake thence south Seventeenth feet to a stake at the  
north side of Kingsley Walk thence east with the same ten  
feet to the beginning containing one hundred and seventy  
feet superficial measure at five cents per foot \$8.50  
to have and to hold to him the said August Sedicomb his  
heirs and assigns forever...

1919, May 30 Sudkersom, Henrietta 85 years old On Sudekum lot Maple

2002 MTSU GSI Survey at City Cemetery identified existing tombstones, monuments and mausoleums. In the area of Section 15-B, there was only one tombstone in Lot 9. ID # 150070. In 2005, a legible inscription was not visible on this tombstone. A re-visit was made to this Lot on April 13, 2013. An inscription could be read on the restored tombstone. The top of the tombstone, with the name Joanna Pless, had been broken off.
